

- Building informal but highly beneficial research partnerships through symposia in three continents'



Cls	 → Direction, expertise, oversight, responsibility. ← Data, publications, events, access to partner networks, policy context, feedback, insights and school communities. 				
CIs	Management Team	 → Coordination, data collection, analysis, events, publications, timelines, reporting, liaison, staffing, finances and planning. ← Data, policy context, guidance, expertise, professional networks, feedback, case studies, parent perspective, school community feedback. 			
CIs	MT	PhD	Data collection, analysis, insight and expertise. ←Policy context, expertise, insight, data, case study studies, parent perspective, school community feedback.		
Cls	MT	PhD	Partner Organisation	 → Data collection, liaison, policy context, guidance, expertise and professional networks. ← feedback, experiences, parent perspective, school community feedback. 	
Cls	MT	PhD	PO	Project participants	 → Data, feedback, context, experiences, insight and case studies. ← Access to other teacher perspectives, understanding of ILEs, insights from research.


