Phases | Skills

Early	Mid	Advanced
Collaborative skills – interpersonal skills, communication and cooperation	Adaptability of practice within teams and various sized groups geared toward achieving student agency	
Comfort with scrutiny and accountability	Team orientation: preferencing goals of team to those of self, adopting the sanctioned vision of teaching and learning	
Flexibility of pedagogical beliefs and practice	Reflexive practice: reflect practice (with specific go	ting on individual and team al of mutual agency)
